



- The unemployment rate is currently 4.2%, up from 3.5% in the summer of 2022
- The unemployment rate is now slightly above where it was pre-pandemic
- This is a relatively low unemployment rate by the standards of recent decades
- This means it is still difficult to recruit staff so you might have to think differently about your vacancies and who could fill them.


